

And a building is born



GE Australia's new Queensland state-of-the-art headquarters is taking shape with its unusual facade and deep centre atrium starting to look like the artist's impression. The \$78 million campus will overlook Stage 2 of the already popular Robelle Domain, a water park themed and much anticipated public recreation area that is also under construction and due to open in late 2014.

Springfield Land Corporation which is managing the design and tenancy of the ultra-modern GE complex says that the site will also have a very well exposed retail and café space. "This is an exciting offering for operators who want a unique slice of something that is going to attract a lot of attention." said Graham Livingstone Head of Commercial.

An independent report estimates that as many as 91,000 people will visit the surrounding water park per annum.
