

South Bank Comes to Greater Springfield

Greater Springfield’s own South Bank-style lagoon and swimming facilities are under construction and will be completed in early 2015. The new lagoon will be nearly as big as Brisbane’s South Bank lagoon and will form the centrepiece of Greater Springfield’s CBD.

On completion, 150 metres of waterways will meander past the inner retail precinct.

The landmark project presents yet another potential economic boom for local businesses and tourism.

An independent Urbis report forecasts as many as 91,000 visitors annually.
