After proudly completing its first year of operation, Mater Private Hospital Springfield is in good health. Over 5800 inpatients and 3400 outpatients have been admitted through the five level hospital, comprising of 64 inpatient beds, 16 day beds, a day surgery unit, four digitally-integrated theatres, medical imaging services and a cancer care centre.

A substantial number of public elective surgery patients has also been treated by Mater Private Hospital as part of a contract with Queensland Health as the ultra-high tech centre positions itself to meet the increasing demand for health and wellness services in the Greater Springfield region.

In the first year of operation, Mater Private Hospital has doubled its staff to a total of 193. The hospital is also a member of a foundation of Greater Springfield's, 52ha Health City precinct in Springfield Central.

Maha Sinnathamby, the development's master planner and city visionary says that what clearly confirms the hospital's important role as an emerging major health care provider for the area is the hospital's number of patients and procedures performed.
