

Fourth McDonald's proposed for Greater Springfield

GREATER Springfield is fast becoming the land of the golden arches with a fourth stand-alone McDonald's proposed for the area.

Plans were submitted to Ipswich City Council on November 30 for a 24-hour McDonald's on the corner of Springfield Parkway and Nev Smith Drive.

McDonald's Augustine Heights opened in July this year joining the existing Springfield Lakes and Bellbird Park restaurants.

The stores all fall within a ten kilometre radius.

Plans for McDonald's Camira included a PlayPlace, McCafe and drive through capabilities.

A portion of Springfield Parkway would be widened as part of the development.
